Participating youth and adults receive behavioral health consultations & trainings, linkages & referrals for services, and case management services, in addition to many other benefits.

Our efforts to continue prioritizing social and emotional wellness for our children and families as well as bolstering Family Support services, which have become more critical in the last couple of years. Covid-19 and the past two years have shone a light on the health disparities among vulnerable populations. Our efforts to combat the social, health and economic conditions in the neighborhood that threaten the success of our children and their families are critical. This has resulted in increased staff training, and hiring a Director of Social and Emotional Wellness as the head of ACCF's Family Support team.

We are also working to strengthen our STEAM (Science Technology Engineering Arts Mathematics) curriculum, helping our students to study creatively. By using problem-based learning methods, our ACCF students can study projects; take thoughtful risks; engage in experiential learning; embrace collaboration; and craft solutions based on real-life examples.
